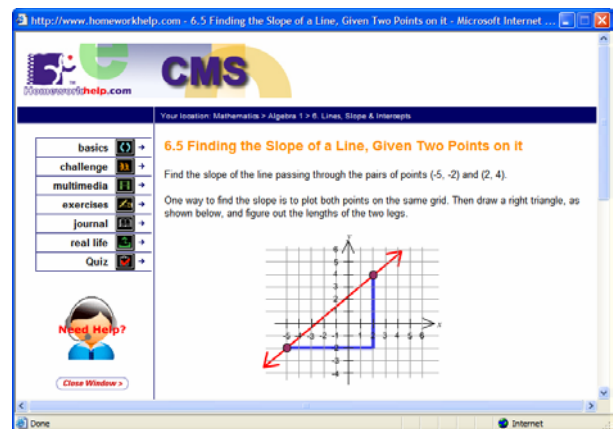

| Exercise |  | The Exercise enhancement allows a student to practice and retain important skills or concepts presented in the lesson. Exercises can be additional practice problems or writing assignments addressing these skills or concepts. |
| Journal |  | Through a writing prompt, the Journal enhancement helps the student make a personal connection to the material presented in the lesson. |
| Multimedia |  | Multimedia enhancements are interactive exercises, activities, or games that use music, audio narration, and animation to teach or review major concepts presented in the text lesson. |
| Real Life |  | The Real Life examples present real-world, present-day problems and examples of the concepts presented in the text lessons. Real Life examples help students understand the relevance and importance of the concepts they learn in the lessons. |
